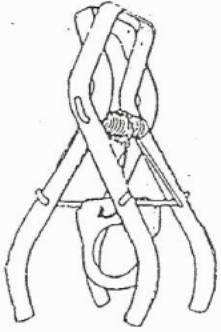


SCISSOR MOLE TRAP

TO SET



Weight 8oz.

Squeeze handles together and insert trigger centrally between bars to keep jaws apart.

The best way to find mole runs is to probe with a metal spike or stick. Open the run with trowel or small spade, clean out and smooth as much as possible before placing the trap.

Insert trap in run so the mole passes through the open jaws to dislodge the trigger. Grass should be wrapped round the trap at the level of the spring. Sprinkle with Soil to exclude all light, taking care not to impede the trap closing.

New traps should be weathered or buried for a few days before use. Rubbing them with a freshly caught mole also helps.

Traps work best in straight or travelling runs, rather than amongst the mounds of soil.

The best runs may be found round the outside of field, or garden, where they leave the hedge, or even along the hedge in a gap or open space.

Runs crossing gateways and paths are also good places.
